Advanced sportfishing techniques and methods for saltwater fly and lure. Sea bass, sea trout and mullet. Learn about saltwater casting, fly tying and selection, how to read various waters and find your own locations, the many influences that will affect your fishing and how to discover /use them. Interact with experts in the fields of fly tying and fly casting on a one to one basis. Advanced lure fishing techniques.

The fishing will be on the south east coast of Ireland and accommodation will be at SEAi self catering facilities. Packed lunches and evening meals will be provided. Places are limited to five per school. Bookings must be made before April 2008. Contact Jim for more details (see below)

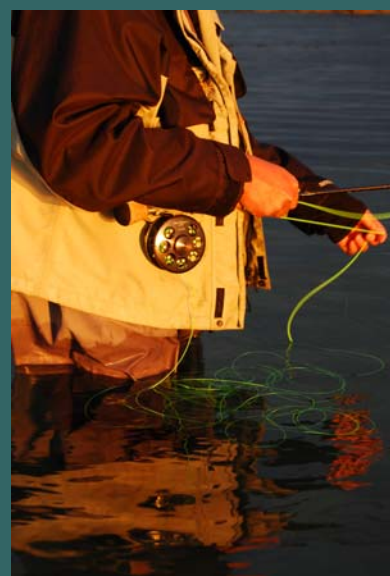
One day courses

Our one day programs are very bespoke and are for people who wish to start or who already have started and wish to improve their saltwater fly or lure fishing. The programs are based loosely over four sessions of one and a half hourly intervals and this can extend or shorten as the customer wishes. Emphasis is placed on a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere and lessons will be held outdoors in pleasant, practical locations and venues when possible. Children over fifteen are welcome provided they are accompanied by an adult and remain under parental guidance during the program and are not charged. **Equipment can be provided if needed.**

Sample One Day Itinerary

Sea Bass sportfishing

- **Arrival :** Details of the local area and how to get to local amenities. Supply of flies and checking of suitability of clients equipment. Introduction to the Irish sea bass and its habitat, biology and feeding habits. How to locate good bass fishing sites. The influences of tide, weather and the moon.
- **Session 1 :** Early rise to meet tides on venue one. Definitely the best time to catch sea bass this is a genuine opportunity for success. ***Fishing the venue for 3 hours.***
- **Session 2 :** Move to second site and a session of casting and fishing instructions. How to read the coast for 'hot spots', how to choose the right fly, what to look for to increase your chances. Sea bass and sea trout their behaviour and your fishing techniques. ***This is a short 2 hour session.***
- **Session 3 :** Drive to venue to catch rising tides the best time to catch sea bass. Move to second site and short session of fishing instructions for the best result at the venue. ***Then fishing venue for 3 hours.***
